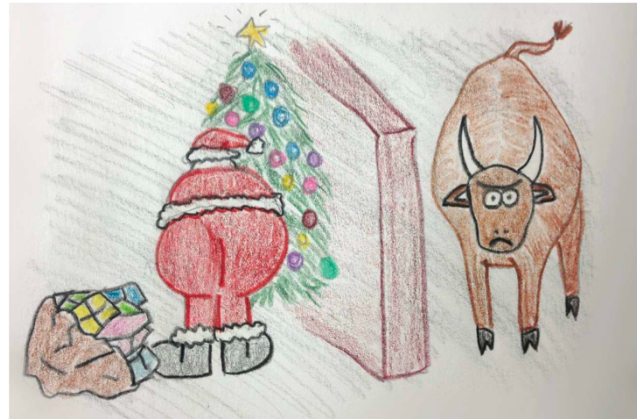
### V1
